The 22-3/4” x 36” (578 x 914 mm) single width printing press will be the first installation of a Quad-Stack in the Caribbean. Amigoe will benefit from the added capacity to print high quality process color in their publications.

The Quad-Stack is a cost efficient 4/4 single width printing press. The proprietary design of continuous paper to blanket contact throughout the printing process allows pressmen to quickly obtain tight registration that stays aligned throughout the press run. The quick registration also lowers the amount of paper and ink waste for printers. The Quad-Stack’s low height and narrow width is ideal for all press facilities. The low height makes installation in most buildings a reality without having to raise the roof, and more importantly keeps pressmen from having to climb scaffolding throughout a press run.
